Laying Concrete around Existing Pool



Designing the area surrounding your pool is as important as planning the pool itself.

Pool surroundings can have various materials. But concrete base around your pool is the best option if you want an amazing pool area.

Concrete is durable, long lasting, and is customizable. You can then finish the surface with a porcelain or stone finish which will fit perfectly with your pool and will be easy to maintain.

NOTE:

- Instruct your landscaping contractor to allow for sufficient expansion joints around the pool structure, to avoid damages on pool structure
- Never dowel into pool structure or you will void warranty
- Never build any structure on top of the pool coping unless the pool wall is specifically engineered to carry the load including fencing, walls and enclosures
- Ensure the Council have approved the concrete before you lay more concrete

Additional concrete works

If you're planning to do other concrete works in your backyard, it makes perfect sense to use one contractor where possible.

This makes a really easy base to erect a glass fence without delay waiting for a landscaper or second concrete crew.

Concrete walkways beyond 900mm are engineered with piers to provide extra support to the pool structure so the weight is evenly supported, or a later expansion joint, starter bars and mesh extension; subject to builders discretion.
